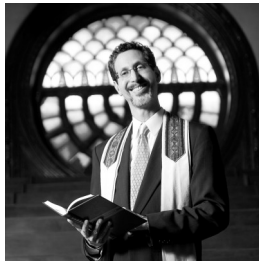


Three Clergy Compare Perspectives on Religious Ethics

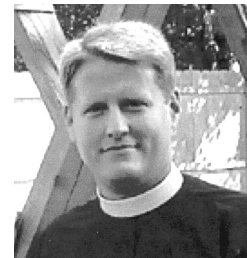
