Defined as “lacking a fixed, regular, and adequate nighttime residence”:

- On the streets or in places not meant for human habitation
- In shelter or transitional housing
- Fleeing domestic violence
- Forced to live with others for no other option
- Forced to live in a motel/hotel.

According to HUD, in 2020, **Oregon had the HIGHEST Rate of unsheltered families with children in the nation:** 52.8% of those that qualify as homeless under HUD’s definition
