November 17, 2019 ~ January 5, 2020

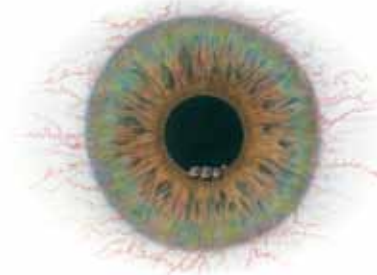
Take a journey to the mysterious Middle East with Rebecca Akporiaye. She uses fine art photography to explore what it feels like to be *From Within*.

January 12 ~ March 1, 2020

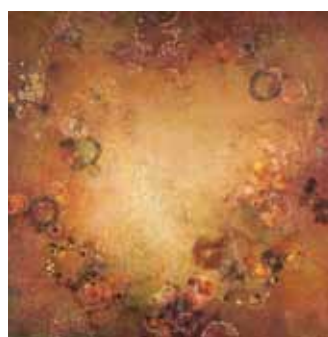
