## **CATHEDRAL BUILDING**

**Sanctuary** 16,570 SF\* \$200/\$240

Stained glass windows, vaulted ceiling, and wood paneling surround the focal point of the altar and brass pipe organ. The Sanctuary is a spectacular venue for weddings, music performances, or large speaking events.

- Capacity: 750 in pews
- Optional: 60 additional chairs behind last pew
- Baby grand piano, tuned at least twice a year
- Rosales pipe organ, Op. 11

**Chapel** 16,570 SF\* \$125/\$150

An intimate space with stained glass windows, vaulted ceiling, wood paneling, and a wood carved altar, the chapel is a beautiful space for smaller weddings and family services.

- Capacity: 80 in pews
- Two-manual pipe organ

#### **OUTDOOR SPACE**

#### Courtyard

38' x 45' grass 3,438 SF

\$50/\$60

Spring blooming trees and plants surround a cement pathway that leads up to the cathedral gates. The grass courtyard is a wonderful area for summer outdoor weddings, concerts, and casual get-togethers.

- Capacity: 125 theater style / 200 standing
- 38' x 45' grass lawn with an additional 16' of sidewalk around the lawn

#### PARISH HALL BUILDING

**Stearns Library** Ground Floor 30' x 19' 570 SF \$55/\$66

A cozy room lined with bookshelves, antique furniture, and artwork, the Stearns Library is a great space for small gatherings, meetings, and breakout sessions.

- Capacity: 28 (theater style seating)
- Large table that seats 8
- Library atmosphere with view of the Cloister and Courtyard

**Bishop Dagwell Room** Ground Floor 17' X 19' 323 SF \$45/\$54 This window lined corner room is the perfect space for meetings and brainstorming sessions. The large tables also provide ample space for artistic get-togethers and crafting.

- Capacity: 16 seats around three seven-foot table perimeter / 20 seats with tables separated
- Neighborhood view from numerous windows
- White Board/easel and small wall-mounted white board

**Morrison Room** Ground Floor 42' X 26' 1,092 SF \$80/\$96 The natural light and calm environment of the Morrison Room makes it perfect for larger meetings, small seminars, and lectures. The bay window area provides a lovely focal point for presentations. The Morrison Room is adjacent to the kitchen, providing easy access for luncheons, small receptions, and full-day events.

- Capacity: 60 (theater style seating) / 20-30 (with long table set-up)
- Retractable projector screen
- Large, portable whiteboard

**Kempton Hall** Ground Floor 70' X 40' 2,800 SF \$125/\$150 High ceiling, wood paneling, and antique light fixtures make Kempton Hall a perfect space for large lectures, receptions, and catered luncheons or dinners. The stage and inlaid labyrinth make Kempton Hall a versatile space for a variety of events. Kempton Hall's proximity to Trinity's professional-grade kitchen makes receptions dinners, and other catered events a breeze!

- Capacity: 220 (theater style) / 160 (20 round tables/8 chairs) / 208 (26 6ft. tables/8 chairs)
- Extra large retractable projector screen, sound system, and mounted ceiling projector
- High vaulted ceiling and view to courtyard
- Baby grand piano, tuned at least twice per year

**Kitchen** Ground Floor \$75/\$90

- Professional-grade kitchen
- Stacking double convection ovens
- 4-burner gas range with oven below
- Flat-top with oven below
- Abundant counter space for workflow

#### **UPSTAIRS**

**St Benedict Room** Second Floor 20' X 14' 280 SF \$45/\$54 A bright and welcoming space featuring icons and a felt wall for storyboards, the St. Benedict Room is a peaceful place for small meetings or brainstorming sessions.

- Capacity: 10
- Conference Table with 10 chairs
- View of courtyard and city beyond

**Choir Room** Second Floor 40' X 27' 1,080 SF \$60/\$75 Large room with vaulted ceiling and plenty of chairs, create an ideal rehearsal space, well-suited for musical ensembles of almost any size. The small stage, located at the front of the room, makes it an ideal location for studio recitals, Suzuki showcases, masterclasses, and other intimate performances.

- Capacity: 60 theater style / standing reception with 2-3 food tables for up to 50
- Small raised stage
- Baby grand piano, tuned at least twice a year
- Harpsichord, tuned at least twice per year

**Children's Chapel** Second Floor 35' X 20' 700 SF \$50/\$60 Medium sized room with vaulted ceiling, leaded daylight windows, and antique furniture, creates an intimate, cozy atmosphere well suited for meetings, rehearsals, music lessons, or as a practice space.

- Capacity: 10 (meeting-style) / 20+ (rehearsal or theater-style)
- Conference Table with 8 chairs
- Children's pews (6) (removeable)
- Baby grand piano, tuned at least twice a year

**Barclays Library** Second Floor 11' X 17' 187 SF \$20/\$24

This cozy library has a bay window seat, wall of bookshelves, and two wing chairs making it a comfy space for small meetings, book readings, conversation groups, and craft circles.

- Capacity: 6 people (meeting or circle)
- 2 wing chairs, window bench and stuffed animals
- Floor cushions

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#### **DOWNSTAIRS**

**Bishop Scott Room** Downstairs 33' X 32' 1,056 SF \$50/\$60 This spacious multi-purpose room has natural light making it perfect for medium-sized workshops, breakout sessions, and art classes. The baby grand piano and plenty of outlets make it a great choice for music rehearsals or lessons.

- Capacity: 56 (theater style)
- Retractable projector screen
- Baby grand piano, tuned at least once a year

**St Catherine Room** Downstairs 18' X 15' 270 SF \$25/\$30 This quaint classroom is a perfect learning space for smaller classes, group music lessons, and tutoring.

- Capacity: 8-10
- Five small square tables (Can be rearranged)

**St Francis Room** Downstairs 23' X 24' 552 SF \$40/\$48 This medium-sized classroom is a perfect learning space for meetings, classes, and tutoring.

• Capacity: 16

**St Nicholas Room** Downstairs 28' X 16' 448 SF \$35/\$42 This medium-sized classroom is a perfect learning space for classes and tutoring as well as meetings and workshop breakout sessions.

• Capacity: 20 theater style / 18 circle of chairs / 14 meeting style with 6' tables

**St George Room** Downstairs 30' X 23' 690 SF \$35/\$42 This medium-sized classroom is a perfect learning space for classes and tutoring as well as meetings and workshop breakout sessions.

• Capacity: 20-25 theater style / 20 circle of chairs / 20 standing reception

**Evelyn Scott Room** Downstairs 25' X 15' 375 SF \$20/\$24 The natural lighting, furniture, desks and chairs make this a great space for youth groups and kid care services. There is easy access into this room from the Bishop Scott room and the Nursery. (\*See Jill Osburn about renting this room)

- Capacity: 8 around circle table
- 3 youth sofas and 2 arm chairs

**St Aiden Room** Downstairs 25' X 20' 500 SF \$35/\$42 This medium-sized classroom is equipped with a large circular rug (12' diameter), making it a perfect learning space for storytelling, children's classes, and tutoring.

• Capacity: 20-25 theater style, 18 circle of chairs
