If you are a gifted cook looking for **steady** part-time work as an independent contractor and would like to work with friendly people without the daily stress of high-pressure restaurants, we want to talk to you!

The chef will have full use of a large and well-equipped industrial kitchen for weekly meals, occasional receptions and other events on Sunday mornings, and additional days & times as needed. Some of the types of events you would cater include:

- Weekly buffet-style community dinner for 50-100, including an entrée, salad, vegetable side, and dessert. Takes place every Wednesday evening at 6:00 pm, September-May
- Monthly lunches & dinners for smaller groups, approximately 15-30 people.
