At Trinity, I find a home for my story. I can confide in friends, staff members, and priests. I can place my story into the vessels of scripture, ritual, and tradition. Trinity allows me to weave my triumphs and longings into the bigger story of our community.

Stories are foundational to the Christian tradition. From Noah's adventure filled with animals and a rainbow to morality tales like the Good Samaritan, the chronicles of faith can inform, sustain, and transport us. They reveal meaning—yet invite us to discern meaning for ourselves.


\$169 per month, we would achieve the campaign goal of \$1,590,000!
